Mr. Camell reported that 30 people attended the working group meeting. ACIL (Mr. Hodes) noted that active loop antennas are more typically used, rather than the passive loops as shown now. The Chair noted that other Standards of ours would have to be modified to include active loops as well. The TCBC (Mr. Wall) added that this would require further discussion. The ARRL (Mr. Hare) pointed out that two measurements would be required below and above $\lambda/2\Pi$. Extrapolation factors of 40dB/decade of distance were proposed below the $\lambda/2\Pi$ point, and 20dB/decade of distance closer to the source than the $\lambda/2\Pi$ point. Mr. Camell said that the tentative timeline is for submittal of the draft to the Main Committee by the end of 2011.

<u>C63.11</u>: Inter-lab comparison of EMC testing Subcommittee 6 Chair: <u>Victor Kuczynski</u> Working Group Chair: Dan Hollihan Status: New Standard. Draft being written.

He wanted to add a half-hour to their allotted meeting time for the next meeting. He acknowledged the contribution of ACIL (Mr. Hodes) for statistical analysis. EMC proficiency is much harder than other types of expertise to demonstrate. The draft should be ready for consideration by the end of the year, possibly by October. He asked for more meetings by webinar or teleconference from now until then.

(The Chair thought it was a recommended Practice, not a Standard) NOTE: Google yields a <u>free copy of C63.12</u>, the Chair will contact IEEE.

The Chair noted that the test method in this document is different from IEC 61000-4-2, with faster rise-times and different simulators. It also addresses furniture discharge, statistical determination of test points, charge-docking ESD on the bottom of the product and low-level pin discharges to Ethernet ports. Mr. Worley hoped to have some text for review by the end of September.

A new generation of nuclear plants is on the drawing boards, with these new plants embracing wireless devices for sensors, etc. These systems will require immunity validation through testing. Low incidence events related to intentional EMI will be considered. C63.20 and C63.24 are using the same working group roster; mostly composed of power industry personnel.

<u>C63.22</u>: Guide for Automated EMI Measurement Subcommittee 1 Chair: <u>Dennis Camell</u>

Status: Current. No plans for further maintenance at this time. Slides were shown: <u>http://www.c63.org/documents/misc/meeting/2011_May_meeting/Main/C63.22_20110505_status.p</u> <u>df</u> Mr. Camell reported that they have an inactive PINS and this Guide was published in 2004. A ballot is now starting for re-affirmation of this Guide. Mr. Kuczynski wanted to promote this Guide through a workshop. The Chair said that several Standards could be combined together to form up a full-day workshop curriculum. When the document goes to ballot, test equipment manufacturers (including software providers) will have to be included.

documents by NIST in their <u>Smart Grid Interoperability Standards list</u>. (pg. 50) There was discussion at the last meeting that we should put together a list of our documents that are relevant to this newly emerging industry. A presentation was shown as posted: http://www.c63.org/documents/misc/meeting/2011_May_meeting/Main/Main_C63R_standards_for_smart_grid.pdf The Chair reviewed the Standards listed and discussed their relevance to the Smart Grid and asked that our work be mentioned when Smart Grid conversations are held.

The vice-Chair verified that all proposed members have paid. He moved to accept the membership as shown, no second was required. The membership was approved by voice vote. The scope was unchanged, so Mr. Camell moved to approve the scope as shown. The scope was approved by voice vote. They have five active Standards and six working groups. Six interpretations were addressed since the last meeting. Mr. Camell will provide text for the newsletter.

AI: All SC Chairs to submit their definitions to Mr. Shellman in SC2 for review by 15 June. SC2 newsletter input was shown. It was suggested that "glossary" be defined. The scope was shown. Mr. Shellman moved to approve the scope, no second was required. The motion passed by voice vote.

<u>SC3</u>: International Standardization: <u>Poul Andersen</u> showed a presentation as posted: <u>http://www.c63.org/documents/misc/meeting/2011_May_meeting/SC3/SC3_20110505_report.pdf</u> The officers were shown. 10 members and 9 observers were present at the meeting this week. They reaffirmed the leaders for all documents under development. Detailed reviews are expected at the October meeting. CISPR chamber validation was proposed for addition. They want three hours for the SC3 meeting in October. CISPR activity was shown. The scope from our website was reviewed by the subcommittee. Mr. Andersen moved to accept the scope as shown with no second required. The motion passed by voice vote. The SC3 membership had several changes from the last meeting. The new <u>membership roster</u> was shown. Mr. Andersen moved to approve the membership, no second was required. The motion passed by voice vote.

<u>SC5</u>: Immunity Measurements: <u>Ed Hare</u> showed a presentation as posted: <u>http://www.c63.org/documents/misc/meeting/2011_May_meeting/SC5/SC5_20110505_report.pdf</u> The officers and membership of SC5 were shown. Mr. Worley wanted to join the Subcommittee and was invited to submit a membership application. Mr. Hare moved to approve the membership, no second was required. The motion passed by voice vote. Mr. Hare moved to accept the scope as shown with no second required. The motion passed by voice vote. **AI:** Mr. Hare to provide SC5 text for the newsletter by 1 June 2011.

SC6: Laboratory Accreditation: <u>Victor Kuczynski</u> noted that 16 members and 10 guests attended their meeting. WG2 was disbanded and will be removed from the web page. AI: Mr Hare to remove SC6-WG2 from the site and implement updates to bring the content current by 15 July . He showed a presentation posted as:

Mr. Hodes volunteered to work on interlaboratory comparison. He was accepted into the working group. Mr. Kuczynski moved to approve the <u>membership roster</u>, no second was required. The motion passed by voice vote. If Mike Violette wants to participate personally, he will need to be part of ACIL membership or pay separately for WG membership, Mr. Hoolihan noted. The Scope was shown from the website. Mr. Kuczynski moved to approve the scope as shown, no second was required. The motion passed by voice vote.

<u>SC7</u>: Unlicensed Personal Comm. Services: <u>Stephen Berger</u> showed a <u>PINS-C presentation</u> for a study project on the test methods for evaluating a wireless devices' resistance to interference from other wireless devices in the intended environment. The Chair asked about how two wireless devices that are allowed to operate on the same frequency would be handled. Mr. Berger noted that this question is about "spectrum etiquette" and is not being considered. Mr. Moongilan asked about how receivers will be addressed. Mr. Berger said that modern electronics often employ power control, which can minimize the chance of interference. (Interference would be less likely when using lower power.) Mr. Moongilan noted that this is about "interoperability."

Medical wireless devices were discussed. Mr. Hodes stated that unlicensed devices must accept any interference they receive. Medical telemetry spectrum has been assigned, he noted. Mr. Berger replied that life-critical medical communications is required to share spectrum. The Chair asked for discussion on accepting or rejecting this PINS-C. Mr. Berger said there will only be two outcomes of this consideration; a PINS or the disbanding of the working group. The Chair asked for a vote on the PINS-C, which passed by voice vote. This should be posted on the website.

The current scope of SC7 was shown. The word "constraints" was inserted into the text. Mr. Berger moved to accept the SC7 "spectrum etiquette" scope as amended, no second was required. The <u>amended scope</u> was approved by voice vote.

The membership roster was shown. AI: Mr. Berger is to contact all voting members of C63 (vmc63@ieee.org) and ask for more participants in Subcommittee 7. Mr. Moongilan volunteered for the Subcommittee as a manufacturer and was added to the roster. Mr. Berger moved to accept the membership roster as amended, which was approved by voice vote.
