1.2. Announcements - Chair - Mr. Hoolihan noted our expanded set of Main Committee meetings this week. (1.5 days)

2. Approval of the Agenda

- 2.1 Approval of agenda- Chair asked for verbal approval of the agenda.

- 3. Special Session on Draft Standards C63.4 and C63.5
 - 3.1. C63.4 Camell Heirman 1330 1430

Mr. Heirman discussed C63.4-201x for the maintenance team. He asked those who have not yet joined the ballot group to do so as the solicitation of the balloting group will close on Friday (April 20). (NOTE

Comments must be made only on the comment form. Comments are made on the "clean" copy, but, not the red-lined copy. The whole document can be commented on during the first review; recirculation ballots limit comments to only the changes that were made.)

There have been at least ten versions of the document, all edited with much labor by Tim Harrington. There was an issue about what kinds of images should be placed onto visual displays; scrolling H's or color bars. After much discussion, a flowchart was implemented showing which images are to be used and under what conditions.

Tablet computers are covered including test setups for these devices.

Hybrid antennas were covered under the revised C63.5, but, C63.4 and C63.5 may not come out at the same time, so Annex N will appear in both Standards. As per the usual practice, undated references are used only for C63 documents, not for externally produced documents.

Additional changes in the DRAFT C63.4 standard include clarifications on site validation above 1 GHz, antenna factors, cable bundling, and text on testing above 1GHz to clarify that aiming the antenna at the source of emissions while performing a full-height scan to find the maxima (-so-called "bore-sighting") is required.

Clause 13 was removed (since that information is contained in C63.10, Clause A.4) for transmitter testing.

Waveguide horns and double-ridged guide horns are required above 1GHz.

Annex B was updated to ensure that both methods of calibrating LISNs yield the same results. A corrected LISN insertion loss procedure and test setup was defined. Use of an extension cord on the LISN is discussed.

The LISN impedance now represents the electrical circuit shown in the Standard.

3.3. C63.5 - Brench, Camell, Hodes, Griffin

As per a special request from Colin Brench, he presented "A Critical Look at Standards and Specifications." He wanted to focus on core topics across Standards and what can be learned for upcoming work?

His presentation covered the following areas: Define all the requirements early; ensure that all users get the same results using a procedure.

Define uncertainty, minimize bad interpretations. Avoid double-specifying. Balance advances in technology while ensuring the integrity of the Standard.

He used IEEE 1597 as an example. It was in a fast-moving field that needed focus on the basics. It used new techniques and was well-accepted.

He showed C63 specifications for OATS specification and antennas up to 1GHz. Log-periodic antennas cover 200-1,000MHz but vary from 0.5m deep to over 1.25m in depth. Log-periodic antennas covering down to 80MHz are over 2m deep!

Above 1GHz, horns of all sorts are acceptable but log-periodic arrays are not. We need to specify the antenna properties that are wanted, with reasoning. Multiple antennas may meet the need of the Standard. We usually don't need to specify antenna designs, however.

Test sites are rarely purely OATS, something is usually in the way. Use of absorber on the ground plane above 1GHz assumes horns, or does it? Define what is needed from the test site independent of the antennas

used. Antenna calibration sites may need more specifications in addition to Normalized Site Attenuation (NSA).

Fully specify what is needed. Avoid double definitions. Avoid definition by example.

Mr. Heirman suggested that we add tolerances to our distances and other variables. Mr. Schaefer agreed, and noted that 5% tolerances were taken from older Military Standards. Mr. Griffin showed a copy of CISPR 32 that indicated a 10% tolerance for many parameters. Mr. Hodes noted that by staying within these tolerances the nominal values in the tables and annexes would remain correct.

Mr. Hodes presented Annex N of DRAFT C63.5 (201x). Causes of errors for hybrid antennas may be: poor VSWR, different balun designs, size of the test site, or a very large-sized hybrid antenna. In general, the hybrids have greater measurement uncertainty than biconical antenna or log-periodic antennas.

Annex N proposes a technically reasonable qualification procedure for the use of hybrid antennas in making final compliance measurements on products.

Annex N defines what a hybrid is and establishes a reasonable balance between best practices and economic concerns. The physical size of hybrid antennas is restricted to 1.55m long x 1.5m width and 1.5m height. The maximum frequency range proposed was 30MHz – 6GHz. Free-space VSWR must be 10:1 or less. (an attenuator may be used). Required equipment was shown: (OATS, chambers, antenna mast, receiver/analyzer, tripod, coax and sets of "identical" antennas). The test setup and procedure were shown and discussed. The acceptable procedure is test site specific.

Mr. Ghizzone showed <u>study results</u> that generated the input for Mr. Hodes and Mr. Schaefer's efforts. A 6dB attenuator was used on all antennas.

Mr. Griffin showed problem statements, an overview of the process, basic assumptions and test data. He concluded that hybrids provided "good results."

3.4. Wrap-up and recess the meeting – Mr. Hoolihan thanked the committee for their efforts and recessed the meeting at 4:29PM until the next morning at 8:30AM.

Mr. Griffin proposed to amend our operating procedures on Interpretations and Explanations.

http://www.c63.org/documents/misc/admin/c63_operating_procedures_2007.htm He felt our

procedure was flawed as only a few members of the working group are involved in generating Interpretations and Explanations. He introduced a proposed amendment to our procedures. Mr. Schaefer thought that we should formalize a process whereby all working group members will be notified of any changes. Mr. Hodes thought that we need a way to issue errata, a process for issuing amendments to Standards, and an expeditious process. The Chair noted that we use the phrase "in a timely manner." Mr. Heirman noted that "60 days" doesn't have a lot of meaning. He thought that any changes in the Standard should be covered in a new PINS. Mr. Camell had concerns about a timely response from the membership. Mr. Schaefer noted our problems with timeliness and website updates. Maybe a response time constraint might be useful. Mr. Hirvela wanted to know if there was an informal way to propose a change to a Standard and note if any objections were noted. The Chair said there was no "informal" way to make such a change.

Mr. Chen was concerned about the formation of a quorum. Mr. Schaefer also asked if we have to hold up the vote with only one negative vote. Mr. Hodes proposed we use "survey monkey" to handle the balloting and determine quorum. Mr. Camell moved to form a working group to evaluate explanations and interpretations and forward them to the main committee for a vote on a viable change to Clause 11, seconded by Mr. Heirman. The motion was carried unanimously by voice vote. The Chair appointed Mr. Griffin and Mr. Schaefer as co-chairs of the "task force" to recommend changes in our procedures within 30 days.

7.2. WG Membership Fees - Mr. Hare showed newly proposed meeting participation fees. Some WG chairs want to invite experts to help with sections of the document. Observers at working group meetings would be charged \$100. Mr. Knipple suggested three "concurrent" experts rather than three in total. Mr. Berger suggested a less formal approach that would have to pass a "smell test" at the Steering Committee. The Chair suggested a change to the language to indicate "at any one time." Mr.

Elliott suggested a fair share not exceeding \$175 for attending a "special" meeting. Mr. Hare moved that "Individual working group members would be charged \$550 per each revision of the Standard." It was seconded by Mr. Hodes. Mr. Heirman suggested that the effective date be June 1, 2012. Mr. Whitesell suggested "each edition" of a Standard as amended wording. The Amended motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

7.3. Canada/C63.4 - Dan Sigouin, Industry Canada - Mr. Sigouin showed ICES-003 Draft 5, issue 3, May 2012 (section 3). One can use either CAN/CSA-CISPR22-10 or C63.4 (2003) with no intermixing to demonstrate compliance under 1GHz. This is the first time Industry Canada has called out C63.4. Section 6.2 gives the upper frequency of radiated measurement.

Mr. Hodes asked why the limits in Section 6 are applicable for CISPR22. Why is Canada using the 2003 version of C63.4? They have been trying to use the newer version, it was reported. Mr. Schaefer asked if there were two different limits. Mr. Sigouin replied, yes, they are different. Mr. Hofmann was glad to know after all these years that we're finally making an effort to harmonize. Mr. Griffin asked about informative labeling requirements. Mr. Sigouin noted that more labeling was likely, not less.
