**Quorum:** 30 organizations + 7 individual members = 37 total. A quorum is 50% +1; which is 19 or more members in attendance. Quorum was achieved with 28 members attending the meeting.

**1.2 Single votes** - We discussed "single votes" under paragraph 8.6.2 of our procedures. Mr. Heirman moved to allow Mr. Hodes to have two votes today, seconded by Ed Hare. The motion passed.

### 2. Approval of the Agenda

**2.1 Approval of agenda - Chair -** The <u>draft agenda</u> was shown line-by-line. Mr. Heirman moved to accept it, seconded by Mr. Hare. The Agenda was approved as presented.

**2.2 Presentation of** <u>C63<sup>®</sup> Patent Slide Set</u> - Ramie - The patent slides were shown and no patent issues were raised.

### 3. Chairman's Report – Hoolihan

**3.1 General -** awards were given for C63.16, C63.26, and C63.12 plus ancillary efforts.

**3.2 FCC Interactions -** FCC docket 1344 published. SC8 filed comments (steering minutes) C63.26 received comments from industry, with recommended adoption. We recommended to the FCC in March that they adopt C63.26 and incorporate it by reference into the FCC Rules.

**3.3 Standards published since 2013 -** a summary table was shown.

**3.4 Membership - vote on HIA -** Mr. Berger noted that HIA represents 90% of the hearing aid manufacturers in the US. He moved to approve the <u>HIA membership application</u>, seconded by Mr. Heirman. The membership application was shown and the Motion was approved by voice vote.

4. Vice-Chairman's Report - Sigouin – Mr. Sigouin suggested we may want to discuss adding a fifth day to our series of meetings as we have new working groups and a new subcommittee.

6. <u>Secretariat Report</u> – IEEE – Sue Vogel - a presentation was shown. AI-21: Sue will provide the Member Interest category of each member for inclusion in the <u>C63<sup>®</sup> members table</u>. There was discussion of amendments, such as the Limited Amendment being written under C63.4a. Harry asked if a consolidated version will be available for sale. The amendment would be purchased separately. AI-22: Sue will inform the Main Committee if a consolidated version of C63.4 (2014) and C63.4a (201x) will be available. Will titles to amendments have dates and linkage to their associated Standard?

**6.2 – Status of PINS and PINS-C** - Three new PINS have been submitted to ANSI; C63.9, C63.15, and C63.26.

- 7. Ad Hoc Committee Report on Revising our C63 Procedures Ghizzone our new procedures are now at ANSI for approval, which is expected shortly. Mr. Hodes moved, seconded by Mr. Hare, to require that electronic ballot results with names be made known to the Members. Mr. Ward felt that the tally should be shared but not the names of the voters. Discussion ensued. The vote was 23 in favor, 1 no, and 4 abstentions. The motion passed. We will now provide the electronic vote tally with Ayes, Nayes, Did Not Vote and Abstentions with the names of each valid voter (for Main Committee matters only).
- 8. Subcommittee reports (Brief written reports to include actions needed by C63®, and items of particular interest during SC meetings). Note: Reports should be provided on the <u>C63 Power Point</u> <u>template</u> and should include Scope, Duties, and Membership for 2016 for each Subcommittee
  - **8.1. SC1: Measurement and Instrumentation-Chen -** The <u>SC1 report</u> was shown. The Scope, membership and duties were shown. Mr. Zhong moved, seconded by Mr. Hodes, to accept the scope and membership. The duties were to maintain C63.2, C63.4, C63.4a, C63.5, C63.7, C63.22, C63.23 and C63.25. Zhong moved to accept the duties, seconded by Hodes,

to maintain the Standards shown. The motion passed by acclamation. Individual working group activities were then reviewed.

- **8.2.** SC2: Definitions Dilay The <u>SC2 report</u> was shown with Scope, Duties and Membership roster. Mr. Dilay moved, seconded by Mr. Hodes, to accept the scope, duties and membership as shown. The motion carried. Working group activities were then reviewed.
- **8.3. SC3: International Standardization Heirman -** The <u>SC3 report</u> pointed out that SC3 deals with harmonization of Standards outside of C63, referencing other Standards and their references to ours. Poul Andersen was thanked for his contributions to C63.12. The membership rosters, both voting and non-voting, were shown. The scope and duties were shown. Mr. Heirman moved, without need for a second, to accept the Scope, Duties and Rosters as shown. The motion passed by acclamation.
- 8.4. SC4: Wireless and ISM Equipment Measurements Wall The <u>SC4 report</u> noted that SC4 deals with wireless and ISM equipment. The membership roster from the SC4 roster page was shown and reaffirmed at their recent meeting. The list of Standards addressed under SC4 was reviewed. Mr. Wall moved to improve the clarity of the Scope of SC4. Both versions of the Scope were shown.

#### **Current Scope:**

Subcommittee 4 provides the technical expertise and resources necessary for developing and maintaining standards documents for measurements of wireless and ISM equipment

#### Revised Scope: (approved by SC4)

Subcommittee 4 is responsible for writing and maintaining existing and proposed C63® standards for wireless and ISM devices (lighting, wireless power transfer, Industrial and dielectric heaters, and similar equipment), as assigned by the Main Committee ASC C63®.

#### Duties include maintaining and managing working groups

The revised Scope was read aloud, including the Duties.A Motion was made by Mr. Wall to approved the Scope, Duties and Membership of SC4. No second was required. The motion carried by voice vote. The second Motion by Mr. Wall (from SC4) was to submit a new <u>PINS</u> for C63.26 Second Edition to ANSI for publication and approval. The new C63.26 draft PINS form was reviewed. Mr. Long pointed out that accreditation bodies were not stakeholders and asked that they be removed, which was done. The motion passed. <u>AI-23</u>: Sue Vogel to copy the new C63.26 PINS content as shown into the ANSI on-line form. We will not be filing reply comments on the C63.26 public notice. Dan will send an e-mail to our attorneys to this effect.

- 8.5. SC5: Immunity testing Whitesell The SC5 roster, scope and duties to maintain four Standards were shown in the <u>SC5 report</u>. Mr. Whitesell moved, without need for a second, to accept the Scope, Duties and Rosters as shown. The motion carried on a voice vote. Individual working group activities were reviewed. Mr. Whitesell moved to approve, without need for a second, the <u>PINS for C63.9</u> as shown. Slight editorial changes were implemented. Mr. Whitesell moved to accept the PINS for C63.15 as shown. The motion carried. Mr. Whitesell moved to approve the <u>PINS for revising C63.15</u> as shown. Slight editorial changes were implemented. The motion carried. Mr. Whitesell noted that C63.16 has been published. The core working group members were shown. C63.24 project status was reviewed.
- 8.6. SC6: Laboratory Accreditation Long Mr. Long showed the <u>SC6 report</u>. A slight change in Scope was proposed. One working group was shown, along with a Membership roster. Mr. Long moved to approve the Scope, Duties and Membership of SC6. Since the Motion came from the SC, no second was needed. There was no discussion. The motion carried on a voice vote.. The C63.8 (WG4) status was shown. The <u>Liasion report from the FCC</u> was listed, along with <u>ANAB status reports</u>. A summary of Action Items was then shown,

including a new attendance spreadsheet.

8.7. SC7: Unlicensed Personal Comm. Services – Bazhanov - The <u>SC7 report</u> was shown, including Scope, Roster and Duties. Al-24: Jerry to add Dave Case of Cisco to the SC7 roster page. The C63.27 title and membership roster was shown. Up to 91 members participate now.

The project status was presented. Mr. Bhazanov moved to request the formation of a balloting group for the C63.27 draft Standard. The motion was seconded and carried on a voice vote. Mr. Bhazanov then moved to submit the draft C63.27 Standard to the Main committee for review, comment and approval for ballot. The motion carried. Sue Vogel asked how long the Main Committee will take to review the document? Al-25: Mr. Bhazanov to provide the C63.27 draft Standard to Mr. Ramie for circulation to the Main Committee for review and comments. Mr. Bhazanov also moved that the Main Committee review of C63.27 and the formation of the balloting group be done in parallel. The motion was seconded and carried on a voice vote. Mr. Bhazanov moved to accept the Scope, Duties and Membership as shown. (C63.27 and C63.17 are the duties). Since the Motion came from the subcommittee, no second was necessary. The Motion carried unanimously on a voice vote.

**8.8. SC8: Medical Equipment Testing – Berger** - The <u>SC8 report</u> showed their Scope, Duties and Rosters. Mr. Berger moved to accept the Scope, Duties and Roster for another year. Two SC8 Standards were discussed, which are the duties. The motion carried on a voice vote. Jeff Silberberg discussed interference reports about nerve stimulators, defibrillators and other implantables. He receives 1,000 EMI reports per year. Many are related to people walking through inventory control "gates."

### 9. New Business

- **9.1. Proposal to change standards revision process Schaefer -** Mr. Hoolihan thought that the Working Group Chairs should check to see if their work impacts other Standards. Mr. DeLisi agreed in the Steering Committee meeting to develop and populate a matrix of potential impacts between our C63 Standards. Don Heirman pointed out that we can use complimentary copies of our Standards for this purpose by requesting them from Sue Vogel of IEEE.
- **9.2. New PINS-C Heirman -** Mr. Heirman and Mr. DeLisi have generated a new PINS-C form for our review. We used to use the same form for both, but confusion was the result. The new <u>PINS-C draft form</u> looks much different. Mr. Heirman pointed out the keyword and definition features of the document. Multiple "project intent" selections were shown. Mr. Heirman moved to accept this new PINS-C form. Mr. Hare seconded the motion. Discussion ensued. The motion carried unanimousl on a voice vote..
- **9.3. Dated vs. Undated Standards Hoolihan -** Mr. Hoolihan proposed that a task group be formed to examine this issue, chaired by Mr. Sigouin. Mr. Sigouin noted that they want three members who favor undated Standards and three that do not to write two white papers for review by the Main committee. Mr. Silberberg noted that there are advantages to each approach. Lisa Perry of IEEE commented on undated Standards that do not require updates in citations. If we are citing a specific part of a Standard, it must have a date. There is no reference to transition dates. Mr. Heirman pointed out that our Standards are voluntary and users choose when to implement them. Mr. Chen asked if a reference is undated, is that referring to the most recent version? Mr. Hodes noted that that was the case. Please submit your request to belong to this task group to Mr. Sigouin, indicating your views on this topic. Mr Hodes moved, seconded by Mr. Delisi, to require a date to complete the reports. Discussion ensued. Mr. O'Dwyer proposed a friendly amendment of a status report in 45 days and a final pair of reports in 90 days. The motion passed with one negative vote from Mr. Hirvela. AI-26: An invitation to join this "Standards Date" task group will be sent to the voting Members of C63

by Mr. Sigouin, copying Lisa Perry.

Mr. Hodes moved to inquire with IEEE and ANSI regarding effective (transition) dates. Mr. Ward seconded. The motion carried. AI-27: The Chair asked Lisa Perry to look into the existence of a transitional period for normative matter.

**9.4.** New <u>PINS for C63.4a</u> - Chen - The new C63.4a draft PINS was shown. Slight editorial changes were implemented. (the sender is now IEEE) Mr. Chen moved to approve the PINS shown, seconded by Mr. Heirman. The motion carried unanimously.

**11.2 Newsletter report – Zimmerman -** The <u>newsletter report</u> was given by Mr. Hoolihan. We want to distribute the May 2016 meeting/newsletter our Committee booth at the Ottawa EMC Symposium.
