- 1. <u>Call to Order.</u> Mr. Marcus Shellman, SC2 Chairman, called the meeting to order.
 - 1.1. Opening Remarks: Mr. Shellman welcomed members to the meeting.
 - 1.2. **Meeting Logistics Announcements:** None.
 - 1.3. <u>Introductions</u>: Mr. Duncanson conducted the roll call to record SC2 membership attendance and determine the establishment of a quorum. The meeting attendee list appears in Attachment 1.
 - 1.4. **Quorum:** Based on the number of SC2 member attendees, the Secretary determined that a quorum had been met.
- 2. **Review and Adoption of the Agenda.** Mr. Shellman called for a review of the agenda, highlighting key areas of significance for the meeting. A motion to approve the agenda was approved by voice vote.
 - 2.1. <u>Approval of the Previous Minutes:</u> Mr. Shellman called for a review of the minutes of the previous meeting. He stepped through minutes of the SC2 meeting held on 08 November 2022 via WebEx, addressing areas of significance. A motion to approve the minutes of the November meeting was passed via voice vote. The approved agenda and minutes will be provided to Jerry Ramie for posting to the C63® website. (See Action Item 20230510 1)
 - 2.2. Review of the Patent Slides: Mr. Shellman presented the C63® Patent Policy slides and polled attendees with respect to knowledge of patent related issues. There were no affirmations of patent issues or objections to the patent policy.
- 3. Review of Subcommittee Membership.
 - 3.1. <u>Membership.</u> Mr. Shellman displayed the SC2 membership as it appears on the C63[®] website, asking whether any changes were needed. It was noted that Mr. DeLisi is the current Chair of ANSC C63[®] in place of Mr. Hoolihan. In addition, Mr. Hare has retired and is replaced as Chair of SC5 by Mr. Braxton, and the Chair of SC6 is now Mr. Kramer and needs to replace Randy Long. The identified changes will be provided to Mr. Ramie for posting to the C63[®] website. (See Action Item 20230510 2)

- 3.2. <u>Members at Risk.</u> Mr. Duncanson displayed the member attendance log, noting there are no members at risk.
- 3.3. <u>Consideration of new members</u>. Mr. Shellman noted that no new applications for membership have been received since the last meeting. The SC2 membership list appears as Attachment 3.
- 4. <u>Display of Scope and Duties.</u> Mr. Shellman displayed the SC2 Scope and Duties, modifications to which were approved by SC2 at the 17 May 2022 meeting and received final approval by the C63[®] Main Committee.
 - 4.1 <u>Election of Officers.</u> Mr. Shellman noted the current SC2 officers, himself as SC2 Chair and Mike Duncanson as SC2 Secretary and Chair of WG1, are affirmed through December 2023. A vacancy remains at the Vice-chair position.
 - 4.2 <u>Approval of the Scope, Duties and Membership</u>. A motion proposed by Mr. Shellman for approval of the SC2 Scope, Duties and Membership was passed by voice vote.

5. SC2 Status, Working Group Reports and C63® Standards Projects.

5.1. Working Group 1 Report. Mr. Duncanson provided an update of WG1 activities since the last meeting. He reported that all edits to draft .14 have been completed and the document is ready for a recirculation ballot, pending the resolution of coordination underway with SC1 concerning 9 of 39 definitions to be included from draft C63.4. He noted SC2 has been in touch with Ms. Santulli about the recirculation and apprised her of the situation with SC1 for which she provided guidance for submission of the latest changes. Mr. Chen reported that SC1 is currently reviewing and generating responses to the SC2 .4 review, noting that completion of the review responses is expected shortly with affirmative responses to many of the SC2 comments. There was discussion between attendees and WG1 about some trends in definition development most often encountered during SC2 reviews. Rationales for some of the more routine comments were discussed and attendee questions addressed. There was consensus that definitions should be for universal use and not shaped for users of the particular standard in which they appear. Mr. Duncanson summarized that the way forward for draft .14, to finalize the document with .4 changes and submit to the IEEE Secretariat for a recirculation ballot. He reiterated that the SC2 decision for .4 definitions requires omission of the attribution to .4 in the .14 entries, as they are considered developed by the C63[®] Committee.

Mr. Duncanson continued with the SC2 coordination status with other subcommittees, providing the status of pre-ballot reviews underway since the last meeting. The reviews involved PC63.4TM/D2.0, PC63.26/D3, C63.9 and C63.16. He addressed the numbers of definitions involved with each draft and addressed the fact that some of these requests for support can be turned around quickly, whereas others with large numbers of definitions can take significantly more time. He stated that the subcommittee is concerned about adversely impacting ballot schedules in cases where significant time is needed to review definitions.

For these reasons SC2 is requesting the SCs consider a 30-to-45-day pre-ballot review period, particularly for draft standards with a large number of definitions. Additionally, he recommended that SCs consider early contact with SC2 when developing new terms and definitions. He displayed the C63® flowchart for definitions development which details the paths by which new definitions are included in draft .14, modified to address the requested considerations.

Mr. Shellman raised the issue of ambiguities in the process to obtain copyright releases for use of definitions sourced from other standards. Based on SC2 experiences, he specifically addressed the need to clarify responsibilities of the IEEE Secretariat to support SCs seeking copyright releases. Mr. DeLisi verified that it is the responsibility of the Secretariat to take copyright release requests from standards WGs, contact the cognizant standardization organizations, and obtain the appropriate copyright releases. Mr. Shellman recommended that language be drafted into the C63® Procedures to explicitly state what the Secretariat responsibilities are to avoid confusion. There was consensus that the Procedures, which are currently under review, should be updated to incorporate these IEEE Secretariat responsibilities.

Mr. Duncanson concluded the report with a summary of the .14 ballot status, SC2 coordination and pre-ballot reviews, and the recommendation that SCs consider early contact with SC2 when developing terms and definitions.

5.2. **Working Group 2 Report.** Mr. Shellman reported that WG2 is currently inactive so that report is tabled at this time.

5.3 C63® Subcommittees & EMC Standards Projects.

Mr. Shellman displayed the active status of C63® standards projects as maintained on the SC2 Agenda and inquired of the group to identify any needed updates. No new updates were identified.

6. Other Old Business.

- 6.1 <u>Written Reports</u> Mr. Shellman stated that the SC2 meeting report will be prepared for the Main Committee meeting.
- 6.2 <u>Coordination with SC2 for definitions</u> Mr. Shellman noted the earlier discussion and reiterated the SC requirement for timely actions for coordination with SC2 on their terms and definitions.
- 6.3 <u>Coordination with SC3 for Harmonization</u> Mr. Shellman noted the responsibility of all subcommittees to coordinate SC3 as well, for international harmonization.
- 7. New Business. None.
- 8. <u>C63[®] SC2 Website Status.</u> Mr. Shellman stated that updates to the SC2 Website will be addressed to Mr. Ramie.
